

## **ENVIRONMENTAL PERFORMANCE**

At LEVANTINA we prioritise environmental preservation, conservation and sustainability as part of our commitment to combatting climate change in our planet, being aware that resources are increasingly scarce because of the actions of mankind.

Grupo LEVANTINA is in the process of verifying the Carbon Footprint of all its subsidiaries in Spain. This will help us to quantify CO2 emissions resulting from our activities within a specific period of time and measure their impact on global warming.

LEVANTINA continues to break ground in the industry: it is the first natural stone company in Spain to have an Environmental Product Declaration (EPD) for one of its products, our Techlam® porcelain solutions. EPDs give credible, relevant, transparent, verified information about the life-cycle environmental impact of products. EPDs are based on international standard UNE-EN ISO 14025:2010, type III environmental label, so all aspects covered by it were verified during the auditing process conducted by AENOR at our premises. With an EPD, clients are provided with transparent information, responding to the market's demand for eco-labels in materials used in sustainable building projects.

Having an ISO 14001-based environmental management system in place at LEVANTINA TECHLAM emphasises the group's commitment to the environment, and this is only the first step in a very long journey. We mainly address those environmental aspects that are most significant to our organization, and these refer to proper waste management, the protection of biodiversity, and the sustainable use of resources in order to minimise our impact.

The actions proposed for 2022 are consistent with our Quality and Environmental Policy, targeted aspects and impacts, and measures to reduce identified environmental impacts.

LEVANTINA TECHLAM uses consumption and waste generation indicators in compliance with the UNE-EN ISO 14001:2015 standard that we can also use later on to carry out trend analyses.

Performance is reviewed and updated as it evolves, reflecting our intention to create a living document and to gain the firm commitment of all stakeholders to its implementation.
